"More Than Just The Two of Us: ABA in Group Settings" – Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is the use of techniques and principles to bring about meaningful and positive change in behavior. A wide variety of ABA techniques have been developed for building useful skills in learners with autism, other developmental disabilities, and typical learners – from toddlers through adulthood.

Typically ABA therapy sessions often involve one-on-one interaction between the behavior analyst and the participant. But how can these techniques be extended and used in structured situations such as a classroom lesson during group instruction, as well as in "everyday" situations such as family dinnertime, or the neighborhood playground?
